Most Worshipful John R. Heisner Lodge #442 Free & Accepted Masons of the State of California Jack Gobel Memorial Scholarship Fund Annual Scholarship Programs

Each year MW John R. Heisner Lodge provides for three types of scholarships. The first type is awarded to graduating high school seniors who meet the requirements of the scholarship program. Masonic relationship or membership is not required. The second type is awarded to graduating high school seniors who meet the requirements of the scholarship program and are also children or grandchildren of MW John R. Heisner Lodge Members. The third type is awarded to college students for continuing college support who have previously been awarded the Graduating High School Senior Scholarship or the Children of the Lodge Scholarship.

Community - Graduating High School Senior Scholarships

MW John R. Heisner Lodge presently is budgeting \$4,000.00 for graduating high school senior scholarships. These scholarships are awarded to graduating high school seniors that will be attending an accredited four (4) year institution of higher learning as a full-time undergraduate freshman. Typically, the committee awards \$2,000.00 to one or two applicants. This is a general public scholarship. In the event no scholarship is awarded to a Community Student, the monies may be reassigned to one of the other scholarships. Masonic relationship or membership is not required.

Children of the Lodge – Graduating High School Senior Scholarships

MW John R. Heisner Lodge also is budgeting \$4,000.00 for two graduating high school seniors who happen to be a child or grandchild of a member of MW John R. Heisner Lodge No. 442. Please note, that this Scholarship is not a general public scholarship and is evaluated separately from that of the Community Scholarship Program. There is no minimum grade point average required for submitting an application. This scholarship is awarded to a Lodge child who is a graduating high school senior who will be attending an accredited four (4) year institution of higher learning as a full-time undergraduate freshman. This year the committee is awarding \$2,000.00 to one or two applicants. In the event no scholarship is awarded to a Children of the Lodge Student, the monies may be reassigned to one of the other scholarships.

Continuing College Support Scholarships

Recipients of both the Community and Children of the Lodge graduating high school senior scholarship programs are also eligible to apply for continuing college support subject to the conditions of the scholarship program. MW John R. Heisner Lodge presently budgets \$4,000.00 annually for the continuing support of our scholarship recipients to attend college. This continuing support is divided among applicants the committee finds most worthy. The amount awarded to each student for continuing support is variable and is dependent upon the merit of each application. Failure to win an award one year does not disqualify an applicant from applying the following year. Nor does wining an award one year guarantee awards in the succeeding years. Each application for continuing support will be individually reviewed for its own merits. In the event no scholarship is awarded to a Continuing College Student, the monies may be reassigned to one of the other scholarships.

The amounts awarded and the number of individuals being awarded is at the sole discretion of the Lodge's Scholarship Committee. All awards are subject to funds available. This fund does not have sufficient resources to grant awards to all worthy students who may apply.

- 2) Student must be a citizen of the United States of America and a legal resident of California residing in the County of San Diego for at least one year.
- 3) Student must have a minimum of an un-weighted 3.5 cumulative GPA.
- 4) Student must be accepted by an accredited 4-yr. institution of higher learning as a full-time undergraduate freshman in the Fall of the current year.
- 5) Student need not show evidence of financial need.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS Children of the

Lodge -**Graduating High School Senior** Scholarship

1) Student must be a graduating high school senior in the current year.

2) Student must be a Child or Grandchild of a member of MW John R. Heisner Lodge No. 442 in good standing.

3) Student must submit a transcript but there is no minimum grade average required for submission of an application.

4) Student must be accepted by an accredited 4-yr. institution of higher learning as a full-time undergraduate freshman in the Fall of the current year.

5) Student need not show evidence of financial need.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS All High School Seniors:

1) A completed application and personal essay of 1,000 words or less.

2) Two (2) letters of recommendation, one from a teacher or school administrator, and one from an adult other than an educational professional who is familiar with the applicant, such as a pastor or scout troop leader.

3) Current official transcript. 4) College acceptance letter.

5) A self-addressed envelope with proper postage for notification purposes

ELIGIBILITY REOUIREMENTS 1) Student must be a former recipient of the Unity Lodge Scholarship for High School Seniors

2) Student must be a citizen of the United States of America.

Continuing College Support

3) Student must have a minimum of an un-weighted 2.0 cumulative GPA. 4) Student must be enrolled in an accredited 4-yr. institution of higher learning.

Scholarships

5) Student need not show evidence of financial need.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

1) A completed application and personal essay of 1,000 words or less.

2) Current official transcript.
